Dear Parents and Carers,

I am thrilled to share some wonderful news with you all! Many of you may have seen in the local paper that our school has been listed as one of the top 10 performing schools in Barking & Dagenham for Key Stage 2 (KS2) attainment. This recognition reflects the outstanding efforts of our pupils, teaching staff, and the entire school community. You can read more about this achievement in the article here:

It is important to note that this ranking is based on *attainment*, which measures how pupils have performed in tests and assessments. However, it does not take into account pupils' starting points, nor does it exclude the data of children who were unable to sit the test. While this recognition is a proud moment, it's essential to remember that attainment offers only part of the picture.

Another important measure used in previous years is *progress data*, which compares pupils' development from KS1 to KS2. Unfortunately, due to the Covid-19 disruption, it has not been possible to calculate KS1-KS2 progress scores for the academic years 2023/24 and 2024/25, as there is no KS1 baseline available to calculate these primary progress measures.
